The Department consulted with respective Sector Skill Council for designing the examination and assessment pattern for the skill development components of the B. Voc. Programs. Sector Skill Councils has developed National Occupational Standards (NOSs) for various job roles in their respective industries. Assessment have conducted for B. Voc. Interior Design and B. Voc. Fashion Technology through respective sector skill council appointed by UGC in every Academic Session and 99.8% students appeared and performed excellent.

Value Added Program on Elementary Sketching and Painting



Workshop on eco-friendly Ganpati Idols making

The three days workshop on eco-friendly Ganpati Idols making workshop was conducted by the department from date 02th September 2015 to 4th September 2015 at Department of Life Long Learning campus instructed by Mrs. Jyoti Gupta . The students of B. Voc. Interior design and Fashion Technology had participated in the workshop. The main aim of the workshop is to show the process of making ganpati idols with the help of eco friendly material like papermeshy clay and vegetable colors. The main highlight of this workshop is the students learned the making ganpati statue and they have given two days workshop on same in many colleges and other departments of University like Institute of Management Studies, Department of Commerce, Gov Girls Degree College, etc. Students get awareness on the importance of eco friendly materials used for the statue making.
