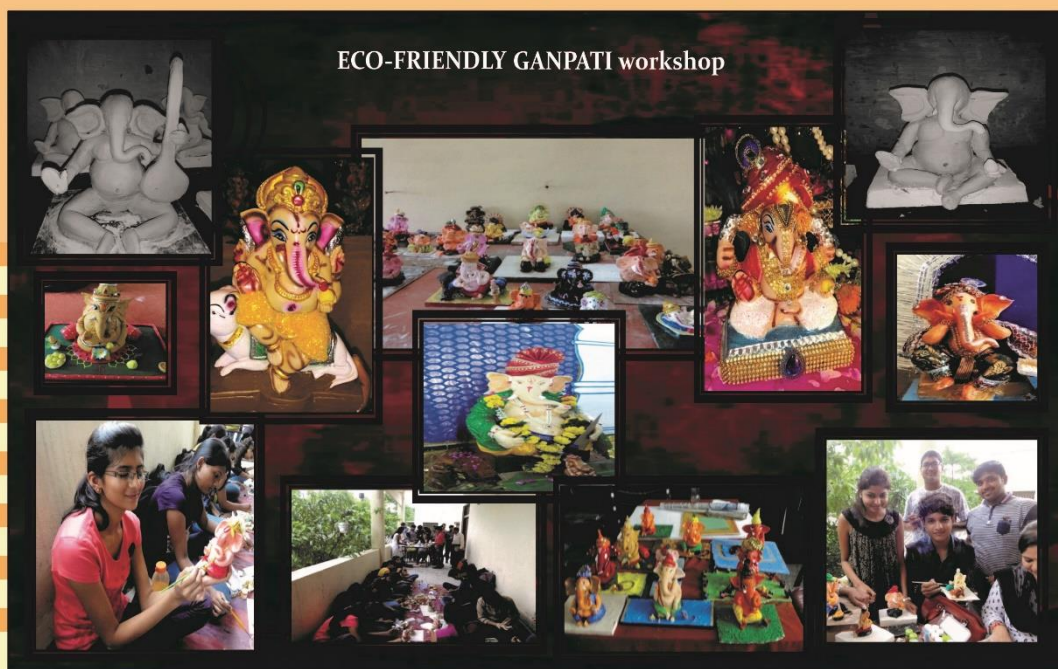

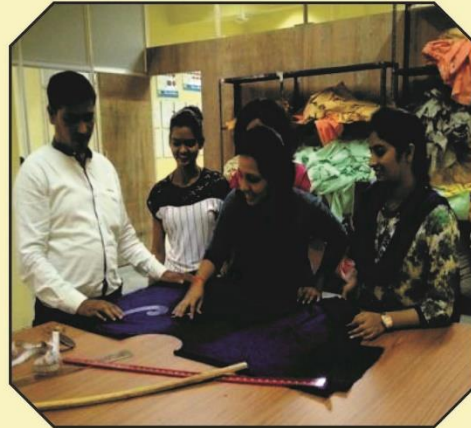

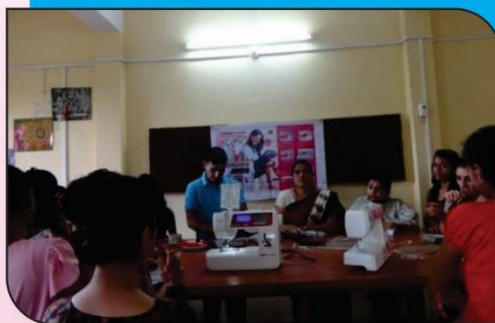


Jewelry creation workshop for students of fashion technology

Annual Exhibition 2017

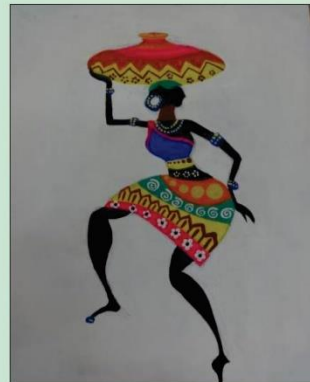
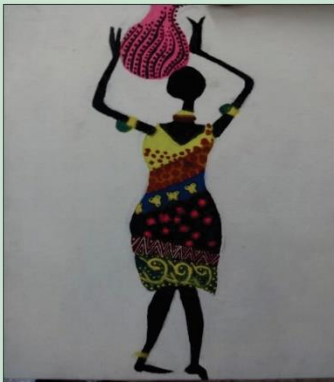

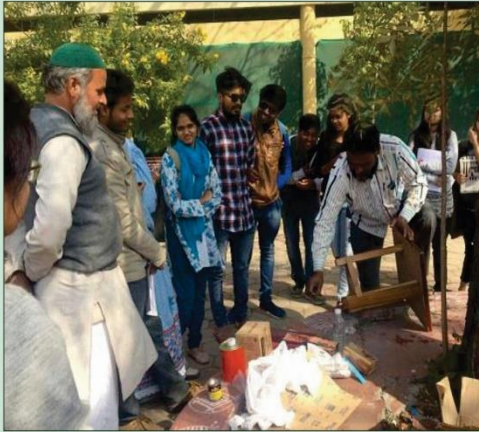
Value added Program on *Elementary Sketching*

He explained manufacturing process of both garments' Students learned how the pattern is made, how the Grading is done from base/medium size to another sizes and what is the sequence of stitching.

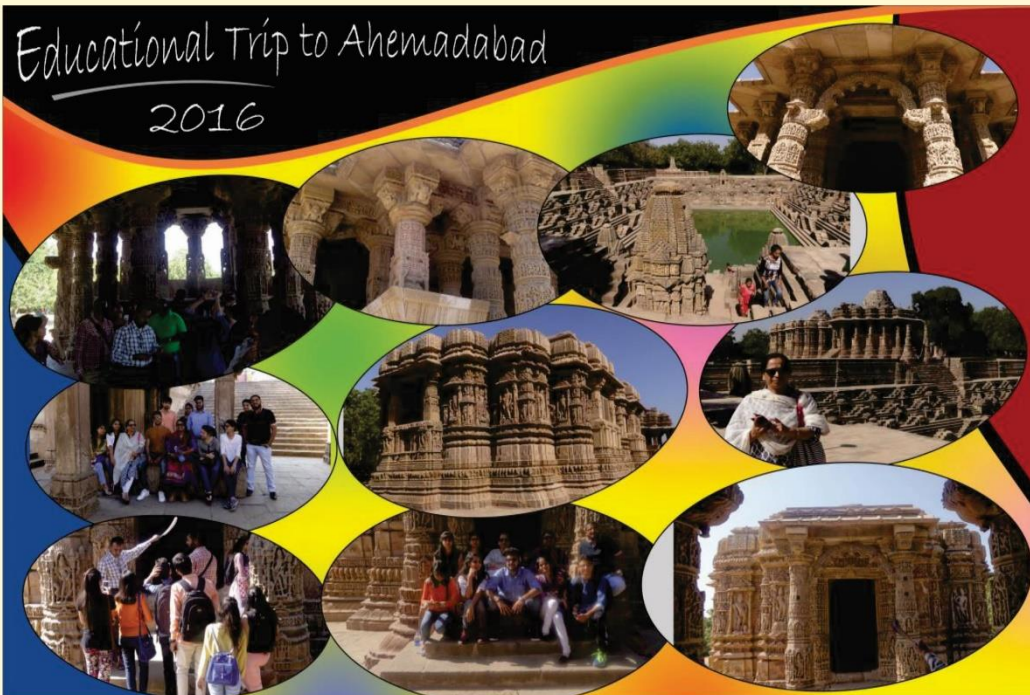
Tie & Dye and Block Printing for Underprivileged girls
